2016 Harvest Award Winners

In order to maintain a premier private fishery, small bass (generally 14 - 16" and under) must be harvested. We believe in harvest so much, that we offer a \$5.00 rebate any time a member submits an online "harvest report" for a lake at which we are currently taking out bass.

This year, our members submitted a total of 470 harvest reports, accounting for over 3,300 harvested fish!

As a thank you to those who take the time to report and harvest fish, each year we recognize the member who harvests the most small bass, and the member who writes the most harvest reports. This year's winners will receive PWF Columbia fleece jackets.

This year's Big Bass Tournament rules are as follows:

General Rules:

- Contest starts February 1st, 2016 and ends May 31st 2016.
- Entry is a one time fee per person of \$25 each.
- All club lakes qualify. (Fish caught in lakes outside the club do not qualify)
- In the event of a tie, the person who paid their entry fee first wins.

Pictures:

- A picture of the fish on a "[Check-It Stik](#)" or similar must be submitted. (Do not use a ruler, tape measure etc..).
- Picture must be submitted by email within 72 hours of your trip.
- Pictures must include this year's unique identifier (this year it is a crankbait)

- Please send a second picture of you holding the fish and let us know how much it weighed. This is not required, just a nice thing to do.

Measurement:

- The mouth of the fish must be completely closed and pushed all the way up against the vertical piece at the end of your measuring stick. Do not pinch the tail.

- Measure to the closest $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.
