


Do You Want to Become a Better Angler?

- Jigs Jigs When to throw a swim Jig, football head, finesse jigs, bladed swim jig, flipping jigs. Don't be afraid to throw one of the biggest bass catching lures of all time.
- Frogs Hollow body or Ribbit Style I love them...but I sure do miss a lot of fish. Here's how to increase your hookup ratio.
- Lots of other lure specific techniques
