

Cody Ranch Trip




It's time for another Cody Ranch trip! The dates are Friday, September 29th thru Sunday, October 1st. The Cody Ranch trips have proven to be a great experience for those members looking to meet other members in the club. Long time member Zach Milwood has graciously agreed to coordinate another trip for us.

Cody Ranch is a property with 8 lakes for you to fish. Your reservation gives you a bed (Cody Ranch added more beds this year) in either the lodge (beds for 9), or the cabin (beds for 3), and three full days of fishing.

You may fish hard all three days, or fish 1/2 the time while napping, playing cards, horse shoes, washers, cornhole, or enjoying a cold beer with the guys. It is your 3 days; you can do what you want. If you can only make it for a day or two, no biggie, come and go as you please during the 3 day stretch.

The cost is just \$300 for the weekend. There are no discounts if you do not stay the entire time. There are a maximum of 12 spots, and 5 of those places have already been filled. Please, contact Zach as soon as possible to reserve your spot. There is a 50% non refundable deposit to hold your spot; we are ready to begin placing charges for deposits. Lake Comedero Trip



Join us for the 2018, bass fishing trip to Lake Comedero, 3 hours north of Mazatlan in the Sierra Madre Mountains. Lake Comedero, is likely Mexico's most famous lake for big bass. We leave for the 4 day trip January 29, and will fish January 30th, 31st, Feb 1st, and 2nd. The cost is \$1995, and a 50% deposit is due to hold your spot. Fishing for the 3 day trip will be February 3rd, 4th, and 5th. The cost of the 3 day trip is \$1795, and a 50% deposit is required to hold your spot.

We have a maximum for 16 spots for each trip; there are 2 available for the 4 day event, and 6 spots available during the 3 day trip. These spots will fill up quickly, please reserve your spot now if you would like to join us on either trip. We will be fishing during the full moon and during the most prime month. Likely the single most wanted week of the year. We have the entire lodge reserved, which holds 12 spots.

During the 2017, trip to Lake Comedero, anglers who caught the bigger fish spent most of their time pitching just a few feet, in the most dense cover imaginable, with 1 oz jigs. You free spool the jig to the bottom and wait for the thud. No thud, reel up and pitch 5 feet to the right. Wait for the thud. No thud, do it again. In most cases 65 to 80 lb braid was required to horse the fish out of the brush. However, fish were caught on top waters, spinner baits, Texas rigs, and even a few on crank baits. But, the best success was horsing them out of the brush.
