**Peacock Bass Fishing the Amazon!**



Peacock Bass Fishing is on the bucket list for many of our ardent Private Water Fishing members. If you are not familiar with Peacock Bass Fishing watch these two videos.



I have been twice, and will be taking my third group of 10 in September of 2018. The Amazon is hot, and the fishing is hard; however, like anything that takes effort, the rewards are great. Our 2016 group landed more than 1000 Peacocks; 40 over 15 lbs., and 11 over 20 lbs.. There is no direct comparison between the size of a Peacock to the size of a Largemouth bass in terms of frequency or difficulty in landing a big fish, but I think a fair comparison is to double a Largemouth Bass's weight when comparing this to a peacock bass. To put this in perspective, a 15 lb. peacock is about a 7.5 lb. Largemouth and a 20 lb. Peacock is the equivalent of a 10 lb. large mouth. Catching 20 lb. Peacocks ain't easy.

If you are looking for reasons to go, here are a few:

\*There is no other fresh water fish that is more ferocious. These fish are pissed off.
